NEW BUILD PROCESS

At Bosveld Homes, we believe the cabinet process should be as enjoyable as it is rewarding. Through a thoughtful, full-service approach, we guide you every step of the way—from design to installation—bringing your vision to life with clarity, precision, and care.

1. INITIAL INQUIRY & CONSULTATION

Every project begins with a conversation. We take time to understand the our client's needs, style preferences, budget, and timeline. During this stage, we often review inspiration photos, talk through how the space needs to function for everyday life, and determine whether stock, semi-custom, or fully custom cabinetry will be the best fit for the project.

2. MEASUREMENTS & SITE INFORMATION

Once we understand the vision for the space, we gather detailed measurements either from the homeowner or builder, or through an on-site visit. Careful measuring allows us to design cabinetry that fits the space precisely while thoughtfully working around appliances, windows, doors, and plumbing locations.

3. DESIGN & LAYOUT

A detailed cabinet layout is created, often with 2D plans and 3D renderings. This phase focuses on:

- Cabinet configuration and sizing
- Door styles, finishes, and materials
- Storage and organizational features
- Code and clearance requirements

Revisions are made until the design is finalized.

4. PRICING & PROPOSAL

Once the design is finalized and approved, we provide a detailed quote outlining the cabinetry costs, any selected upgrades, and additional services such as delivery, installation, or custom modifications.

5. FINAL SELECTIONS & ORDER PLACEMENT

Once all design details are finalized, the client confirms their selections, including the cabinet door style, finish, hardware, and other elements. After approval, the order is submitted to the manufacturer or moved into production for custom cabinetry. At this stage, changes may be limited as materials and production schedules are put into place.

6. PRODUCTION

Cabinets are manufactured or built according to the approved specifications. Lead times vary depending on whether the cabinets are stock, semi-custom, or fully custom.

7. DELIVERY

Once the production is complete, the cabinets are delivered to the job site or warehouse. They are then inspected for accuracy and quality before installation.

8. INSTALLATION

Once the production is complete, the cabinets will be professionally installed, leveled, and secured. This phase may also include fitting panels, trim, and specialty features.

9. FINAL WALKTHROUGH & ADJUSTMENTS

A final walkthrough ensures everything meets expectations. Any minor adjustments, touch-ups, or warranty items are addressed.
